5. VISIT A MUSEUM

In Liverpool we have many <u>museums</u> and art galleries to enjoy, from the World Museum to the Tate, we really have it all.

6. FERRY 'CROSS THE MERSEY

Life goes on day after day... Take a trip on the River Mersey onboard the Snowdrop for the <u>River Explorer</u> <u>Cruise</u> to see the Liverpool and Wirral waterfront from a different perspective or hop off and explore the Wirral peninsula.

7. VISIT THE PALM HOUSE

A popular film location, why not head outside of the city centre and visit Sefton Park, home to the magnificent <u>Palm House</u> and spot the variety of flowers and plants.

8. TAKE A SELFIE WITH THE LIVERPOOL SIGN

9. ENJOY OUR TWO CATHEDRALS

Liverpool has two wonderfully unique cathedrals - <u>Liverpool</u> <u>Cathedral</u> and <u>Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral</u> - and they're truly a must-see when visiting the city!

10. GO THE THEATRE

We have many theatres across the city from the <u>Empire</u> to the <u>Royal Court</u>, there's loads on offer for those who love the stage!





Head to Nelson Street and spot the beautiful Chinese arch standing at 13.5 metres tall. It marks Europe's oldest Chinese community with a selection of Chinese & pan-Asian restaurants dotted along the way.

12. ENJOY A FILM

Go and enjoy a film at some of the city's most loved cinemas - <u>The Everyman</u>, <u>Odeon Liverpool ONE</u> and <u>FACT</u>.

13. GO THE BEACH

We have some really wonderful, scenic beaches honest! From West Kirby to Crosby, our coastline is truly a thing of beauty. Most of our coastline can be reached by hopping on board a Merseyrail train from any of the city centre stations. If you spot Antony Gormley's Another Place at Crosby beach, be sure to take a snap!

14. HAVE A GHOSTLY ENCOUNTER

With Liverpool's long history, there's inevitably a long list of spooky ghost tales that come with it. There are some interesting tours to take part in such as Shiverpool where you can find out all about Liverpool's ghoulish past! <u>Click here to book tickets.</u>

15. GO MURAL SPOTTING

There has been an explosion of colourful and creative murals across the city, from the replica Abbey Road on Grafton Street to the Liver Bird wings mural by Paul Curtis on Jamaica Street - you must grab some snaps of these when you're nearby!

16. GO SHOPPING

Liverpool has plenty of options to go shopping with the likes of <u>Liverpool ONE</u>, <u>The Metquarter</u>, <u>Harvey Nichols</u>, and <u>Flannels</u>. But there are also hidden gems with local retailers such as <u>Utility</u> and <u>Merseymade</u> where you can find some Liverpool momentos to take home with you!

17. HEAD TO A ROOFTOP

There are a few decent roof top bars in Liverpool city centre with the likes of <u>Goodness Gracious</u>, <u>Liberte Sky Garden</u> and <u>Pins</u> all boasting gorgeous outdoor spaces with unique views of the city, There is also <u>Matou</u> restaurant which has a view of the Mersey and also a unique vantage point of the Three Graces.

18. FIND THE BOMBED OUT CHURCH

St Luke's Church, known locally as the <u>'Bombed Out</u> <u>Church'</u>, suffered catastrophic damage during the May Blitz of 1941, leaving only an external shell. It is now used for many arts events with a garden bar & cafe open in the warmer months.

19. TRAVEL THE CITY ON AN E-SCOOTER

With 400 e-scooters from Voi dotted across the city, why not rent one of these and enjoy the city centre from a different perspective. Just download the <u>app</u>, register and scan the QR code and hop on board.

20. GO TO A GIG

Everywhere you walk around Liverpool. you'll hear music. It's in our DNA! Plenty of venues across the city have live music on every night. Head in the direction of Seel Street or Mathew Street to enjoy or click on <u>VisitLiverpool</u> to find out more.

THE BEATLES

You didn't think you could come to Liverpool without a little help from your friends now did you?

THE CAVERN CLUB

With live music from 11.30am every day, The Cavern Club is a must-see when you visit the city, soak up some iconic Liverpool music history while spotting all the artists who have played there over the years.

THE BEATLES STORY

(immerse yourself in the life & times of the Fab Four at this museum with everything from John Lennon's spectacles to Ringo Starr's drum all on display.

FAB FOUR STATUE

You may recognise this from Carpool Karaoke, but while at the iconic Pier Head, get a selfie with John, Paul, George and RIngo! Who knows who you may bump into.

MAGICAL MYSTERY TOUR

Roll up, roll up to the <u>Magical Mystery</u> <u>Tour!</u> Get onboard and be transported around the city's Beatle locations from childhood homes to Penny Lane, this is not to be missed!

THE BEATLES MUSEUM

While on Mathew Street, pop your head in to <u>Liverpool Beatles Museum</u> with unique, authentic artefacts curated by Roag Best, son of Neil Aspinall & Mona Best and brother of original Beatle drummer, Pete Best.

YE CRACKE

Have a drink at Ye Cracke pub, where John Lennon and Stuart Sutcliffe used to drink while at Art School & enjoy the Beatle paraphenalia on the walls.
